Day 1

Lima [D]

Arrival in Lima & Transfer to Hotel - at passengers' expense

Morning experience: Lima Boardwalk Biking Tour (optional)

Discover Lima by bike as you ride along its scenic Pacific coastline, from San Isidro and Miraflores to Barranco and Chorrillos, taking in sweeping ocean views, a relaxed pace, and a special pause to enjoy a local snack while connecting with the city's coastal essence.

Discover Lima through its pisco, from classic pisco sours to creative cocktails, each paired with delicious bites, as you explore everything from elegant hotel bars to historic taverns with a local host, enjoying the city's flavors, stories, and vibrant spirit in every sip.

Gourmet Dinner at Huaca Pucllana

Once a ceremonial and administrative hub, Huaca Pucllana is an ancient adobe pyramid that still stands proudly in one of Lima's most modern districts. Admire this sacred monument while enjoying a fine dining experience at an elegant restaurant right beside it.

Viceregal Lima visit

On this tour of Lima's Historic Center, visit a Franciscan Monastery and a colonial manor from the 16th century to glimpse the lifestyle of that era. Stroll through the Main Square and Cathedral, witness the Presidential Palace's changing of the guard, and walk along Jirón de la Unión to reach Plaza San Martín, built to mark the centennial of independence.

Garden Side Meal

Savor a delightful lunch at the renowned Café del Museo, set within the beautiful Museo Larco. Surrounded by centuries of history and art, this elegant space offers a refined ambiance and a menu that highlights the best of Peruvian cuisine with a contemporary touch—perfect for a memorable midday experience in Lima.

Afternoon Museo Larco Visit

Discover the Larco Museum's impressive collection, housed since 1926 in an 18th-century viceregal hacienda. Its exhibits span 5,000 years of Peruvian history, from the origins of Andean civilization to the Inca era. Through these invaluable pieces, gain insight into the worldview and philosophy of ancient Peruvians.

During a guided tour of approximately three hours, you will explore one of the most extraordinary archaeological sites in the world, admire breathtaking views, and learn about the history, architecture, and legacy of the Inca civilization.

After the visit, you will return to Aguas Calientes and board the train back to Ollantaytambo. From there, your private transportation and guide will accompany you back to your hotel in Cusco.

Chalwacocha Community Experience with Pachamanca lunch

From Cusco, you will travel to the community of Challwacocha for an authentic Andean experience with the PALLAY project, where tradition comes to life. Upon arrival, the women artisans will guide you through the complete textile process—from alpaca and sheep fiber, hand spinning, and natural dyes, to backstrap loom weaving—showing how each piece is created with meaning and care.

As part of the experience, the group will also participate in a discussion on social entrepreneurship and emerging markets, learning how PALLAY has transformed traditional craftsmanship into a sustainable business model that creates economic opportunities while preserving cultural heritage.

The experience includes a traditional pachamanca lunch shared with the community, followed by a Pachamama ritual, a meaningful moment of gratitude and connection with the land.

Pallay Textile Boutique Visit

Complete the Pallay experience with a visit to their boutique in Cusco, where you'll see how traditional artisan work is transformed into a finished product. This visit offers valuable insight into social entrepreneurship, branding, and business development in emerging markets.

Farewell Dinner

For dinner, enjoy a 3-course meal at a restaurant that is famous for its innovative approach to traditional Andean cuisine by combining it with international techniques.

- Prices are based on a group of 20 participants minimum.





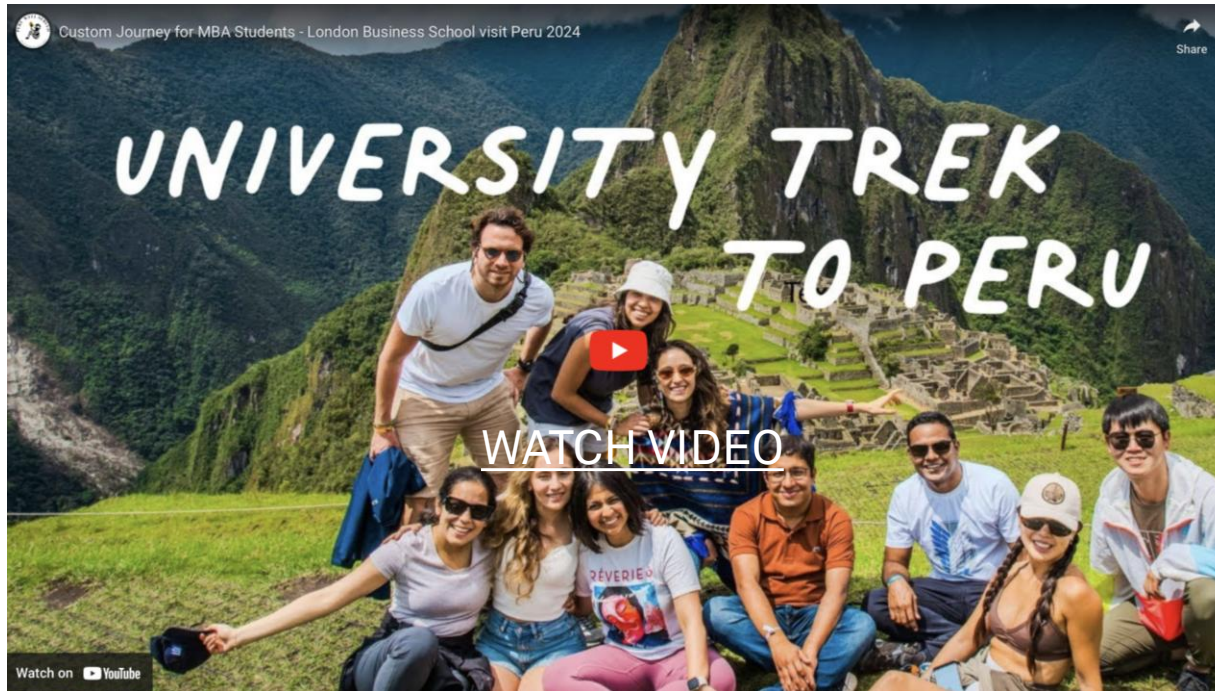
