What is SIIF?

The Social Impact Internship Fund is a financial commitment to the professional and personal achievements of MBAs in unpaid or low-paying social impact summer internships, helping to foster a vibrant, socially-minded, and enriched student community full of future impact-oriented business leaders.

SIIF STIPEND ELIGIBILITY

To qualify for SIIF you **must**:

- Be a first-year, full-time MBA student
- Secure a summer internship in a social impact field. A confirmed position is **not required** at the time of application.
 - If selected as a recipient, you must provide an acceptance letter before fund disbursement.
- Earn **less than \$6,000**, including all forms of compensation (e.g., salary, stock options, foreign currency). SIIF recipients may not accept additional employment that would cause earnings to exceed this limit.

You **do not** need to be:

- a member of Net Impact
- a US citizen

MIGHT BE ELIGIBLE

Questions to consider:

- Is the organization a certified benefits corporation (i.e. B Corps)?
- Is there a social component embedded in the organization's mission?
- Does my position directly advance the mission?

 - Social impact component of the organization/internship
- Short Answer Question
 - Net Impact's mission is to give students the opportunity to "Use the power of business to solve societal challenges and make the world a better place." Please explain how your internship aligns with this mission and how it supports your career goals post internship. Include the following information [max 250 words]:
 - Your Role
 - Where the social impact component fits in
 - How you will use your MBA skills

*A strong application will clearly demonstrate **your direct social impact** this summer.*

SELECTION COMPONENTS

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER YOU APPLY?

Applications for funding will be evaluated by a panel of individuals from the program office, the career center, and Net Impact based on the following criteria:

- 1) Social impact/alignment with Net Impact's goals
- 2) Benefit to applicants' career goals & utilization of MBA skills
- 3) Financial need & cost of living

If there's anything that we would like more information on, you may be invited for an interview during the application stage. You will receive a final response on or about May 15th.

How are award recipients chosen?

The committee will evaluate applications based on social impact, utilization of MBA skills, and financial need.

What if I have not accepted an internship yet?

Please still apply and describe the organizations you are considering. The committee will need to follow up with you to better understand your summer needs.

How many people usually receive SIIF?

It depends. We do not set a limit for the number of applicants we intend to fund. However, the total number of eligible applicants, as well as the amount of available funds will dictate the number of applicants who ultimately receive a SIIF stipend.

How much will I receive?

It depends on how many people applied, your financial needs, and length/hours of work.
